The Montclair Film Festival Emerging Filmmaker Competition Opens October 1

Film submissions now being accepted in multiple creative categories from students in Grades 4-12

October 1, 2015, Montclair, NJ— The Montclair Film Festival (MFF) today announced that submissions are now open for the annual Emerging Filmmaker program (formerly *Kidz Shortz*). This competition is open to children from around the world interested in submitting short films in the Narrative, Documentary, Animation, and Experimental film categories.
